



Have you any good advice about arranging a funeral?

Death is the one 'certainty' of life. None of us can ever 'know' when our funeral service will take place. It is of great comfort to those left behind to know *what and where* we would like for our funeral. The personal advice of Trinity's minister is this: after reading this commit to paper some basic ideas of the place and content of your funeral. State whether your preference is cremation or burial. File your instructions with the documents that loved ones will most readily turn to when arranging your funeral. All Funeral Directors offer the option of a 'Pre-Paid Funeral' (with the benefit of relieving your loved ones from the burden of payment at the time of your death); 'Pre-Paid Funeral' arrangements include your instructions on content and place.

The church takes seriously **the care of the dying** – whether a member of the church or not – and anyone wishing for a visit to a loved one is welcome to contact the Minister.
